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89-92 POINTS	2014 Stone Côte Vineyard Sonoma Coast CHARDONNAY	The 2014 Chardonnay Stone Cote Vineyard is laced with pretty floral, spice, apricot pit, orange peel and lightly buttered notes, all in a mid-weight, gracious style that will drink well young early. The Stone Cote emerges from a parcel within the famed Durrell Vineyard.	8
90-92 POINTS	2014 Three Jacks Vineyard Green Valley of the Russian River Valley CHARDONNAY	Hartford's 2014 Chardonnay Three Jacks Vineyard captures the richness and intensity that are typical of Russian River. Orange peel, honey, chamomile, wild flowers and hints of tropically-leaning fruit give the 2014 an expressive, extroverted edge.	8
90 POINTS	2014 Four Hearts Vineyards Russian River Valley CHARDONNAY	Hartford's 2014 Chardonnay Four Hearts Vineyards is seamless, textured and totally silky on the palate. Here it is the wine's palate feel and suave personality that stand out most. Peach, apricot pit, honey, butter and hazelnut are some of the signatures in this voluptuous Chardonnay. The Four Hearts is mostly old-vine fruit from Dehlinger. This is a strong showing for Hartford's entry-level Chardonnay.	9
90-92 POINTS	2014 Fog Dance Vineyard Green Valley of the Russian River Valley CHARDONNAY	The 2014 Chardonnay Fog Dance Vineyard is one of the most succulent, forward wines in the range. Apricot pit, peach, smoke, candied lemon and exotic flowers flesh out in a plush, inviting Chardonnay with considerable near and medium-term appeal.	8
91-93 POINTS	2014 Far Coast Vineyard Sonoma Coast CHARDONNAY	The 2014 Chardonnay Far Coast Vineyard is endowed with a real sense of phenolic intensity and breadth, which serves to balance the more overt, tropically-leaning elements that develop in the glass. A wine of true distinction, the 2014 will drink well for at least a handful of years. Clean, saline notes buffer the finish. The Far Coast emerges from a vineyard that sits at 1,000 feet above sea level. It is also one of the most distinctive wines in the range.	Ç
90-93 POINTS	2014 Seascape Vineyard Sonoma Coast PINOT NOIR	The 2014 Chardonnay Seascape Vineyard presents a very different expression of Chardonnay than the Far Coast. Apricot jam, wild flowers, honey and chamomile are some of the signatures. Winemaker Jeff Stewart likes to open the canopy here to stave off disease pressure, which also gives this wine a bit more raciness in its fruit than the Far Coast.	Н.
89-91 POINTS	2014 Marin County Marin County PINOT NOIR	Bright red cherry, cranberry, orange peel, cinnamon and sweet floral notes are all pushed forward in the 2014 Pinot Noir Marin County. Vibrant to the core, the 2014 is an ideal Pinot for drinking over the next few years, while the flavors retain their youthful energy. Veins of underlying salinity give the flavors a real acid-driven pop.	
90-93 POINTS	2014 Seascape Vineyard Sonoma Coast PINOT NOIR	The 2014 Pinot Noir Seascape Vineyard is round, polished and seductive, with a lovely mid-palate pliancy and plenty of generosity. Spice, new leather and menthol wrap around the inviting finish. Rose petal, savory herbs and mint add the closing layers of nuance.	
90-93 POINTS	2014 FOG DANCE VINEYARD GREEN VALLEY OF THE RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY PINOT NOIR	Bright red cherry, pomegranate, wild flowers, mint and blood orange are some of the signatures in the 2014 Pinot Noir Fog Dance Vineyard. Mid-weight and gracious in style, the Fog Dance is another very pretty wine. Here, too, the vibrant acidity is very much front and center.	
90-93 POINTS	2014 Hailey's Block Green Valley of the Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	The 2014 Pinot Noir Hailey's Block is one of the more exuberant, racy wines in the Hartford range. Succulent dark cherry, plum, spice, menthol, licorice and cloves flesh out in a powerful, inviting wine. The 2014 is bold, juicy and forward, all of which make it an excellent choice for drinking over the next few years.	
89-92 POINTS	2014 Muldune Trail Anderson Valley PINOT NOIR	The 2014 Pinot Noir Muldune Trail is powerful, rich and incisive, with notable depth and power. Dark cherry, plum, mocha, spice meld into the succulent, radiant finish. Drink this forward, juicy Pinot Noir over the next handful of years. Muldune Trail emerges from a site at the southern end of Anderson Valley.	

89-92 POINTS	2014 Velvet Sisters Anderson Valley PINOT NOIR	The 2014 Pinot Noir Velvet Sisters is a little bit more severe and narrow in its overall feel than most of the Hartford Pinots. Dark cherry, plum, menthol, violet and licorice are all nicely delineated today. It will be interesting to see what happens as the wine finishes its aging and goes into bottle.
89-92 POINTS	2014 MacLean's Block Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	The 2014 Pinot Noir MacLean's Block is another wine that presents a bit of an austere edge today. There is plenty of power and intensity, but the mid-palate is somewhat compact at this stage. Savory herbs, graphite, wild flowers and a host of dark-fleshed fruits open up, but only with considerable reluctance. Still there is good potential here.
90 POINTS	2014 Land's Edge Vineyards Sonoma Coast PINOT NOIR	The 2014 Pinot Noir Land's Edge Vineyard is plump, juicy and approachable. Floral and savory notes add aromatic lift to the intense dark fruit, yet this remains an especially succulent Pinot for the Sonoma Coast.
90-93 POINTS	2014 Far Coast Vineyard Sonoma Coast PINOT NOIR	The 2014 Pinot Noir Far Coast Vineyard is one of the most overt, juicy Pinot Noirs in this range. Plum, black cherry, cola, sweet spices and leather fill out the wine's frame quite nicely. Drink this plump, juicy Pinot Noir over the next handful of years.
89-92 POINTS	2014 Jennifer's Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	The 2014 Pinot Noir Jennifer's emerges from one of the coolest areas in the Russian River, which gives the wine much of its sense of restraint. Dark cherry, graphite, mint, sage and lavender are all given an extra kick of brightness from the vibrant acidity that is so pronounced in this vintage. The Jennifer's is another expressive, nuanced wine from Hartford.
90-93 POINTS	2014 Arrendell Vineyard Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	One of the flagships in this range, Hartford's 2014 Pinot Noir Arrendell Vineyard is sweet, perfumed and totally gracious on the palate. Silky tannins, nuanced aromatics and an emphasis on finesse rather than power are some of the many signatures. This is a vivid, wonderfully nuanced Pinot from Hartford.

92 POINTS	2014 Russian River Valley ZINFANDEL	The 2014 Zinfandel (Russian River Valley) is dark, juicy and flavorful, with plenty of acid kick to prop up the flavors, dark cherry, blackberry, spice and violets are pushed forward. Drink this delicious Zinfandel over the next few years.
94 POINTS	2014 Jolene's Vineyard Russian River Valley ZINFANDEL	The 2014 Zinfandel Jolene's Vineyard is aromatic, lifted and nuanced, with pretty earthy, savory undertones that add complexity. This is an especially gracious mid-weight Zinfandel. A host of bright red stone fruit and pomegranate notes add the closing shades of nuance.
95 POINTS	2014 Fanucchi-Wood Road Vineyard Russian River Valley ZINFANDEL	One of the highlights in this range of Zinfandels, the 2014 Fanucchi-Wood Road Vineyard is also one of the very best wines in the entire lineup. Lifted and gracious on the palate, the Fanucchi-Wood Road has a very distinctive red fruit profile that can probably be traced back to the Carignane that is planted here. Today, the 2014 is absolutely compelling.
