Lemony in rock candy and salty stone, this is a lively, fresh and full-bodied white from an estate vineyard. It is also flinty and fleshy, with complex layers of texture. Fresh hints of tangerine and grapefruit contribute a lively brightness that persists through a long, beautiful finish. – Virginie Boone, July 2022

This bright, effusive wine is juicy in citrus and mango. It's also flinty and bursting in sea spray, offering a lush, voluptuous midpalate of complex concentration. The contrast leads to a viscous, lengthy finish of floral beauty. – Virginie Boone, July 2022

Tangy layers of tangerine and wet stone fill the glass in this fresh, focused and ultimately bright coastal white. Salty sea air lingers around strong, lush layers of richness and complex concentration, finishing in persistent acidity. – Virginie Boone, July 2022

Mango, banana and pear meet a rich core of crème brûlée and oak spice in this deliciously complex and concentrated wine. It has lush, plush undertones of pillowy texture and a finishing touch of orange zest that help brighten and lengthen the finish. – Virginie Boone, July 2022

Rich in ripe pear and a lovely note of vanilla bean, this white offers a crisp, mineral-like backbone of acidity and structure that shows its coastal beginnings. White flower, dried herb and sea spray contribute a beguiling character amidst the full-bodied weight of the wine. – Virginie Boone, July 2022

Seamless and supple in a lightness of baking spice, apple, pear and flint, this wine offers a nice contrast between fruit mineral, with a texture of crushed rock. Made in a big, brawny style, it delivers plenty of complex power and richness to intrigue. – Virginie Boone, July 2022

Opening in a strong perfume of oak, this robust, concentrated white offers woody spice, lively acidity and rich layers of Gravenstein apple, tangerine and ginger. A lush finish accentuates its bold, memorable personality. – Virginie Boone, July 2022

With a big, rich opening of toasted oak, this crowd-pleasing wine delivers tropical richness and intensity around a spicy complement of baking spice and vanilla. It is well made and balanced within a full-bodied style. Editor's Choice. – Virginie Boone, July 2022

Brioche aromas lead the way on the nose of this bottling, which also offers ripe pear and drizzles of honey. The single-vineyard expression is more subtle on the sip, with lemon-glaze, baked peach and warm oak flavors achieving a restrained balance. – Matt Kettmann, July 2022

2020 Jurassic Vineyard Santa Ynez Valley CHENIN BLANC Clean, crisp and restrained on the nose, this bottling offers apple-flesh and lemon-peel aromas on the nose. The palate is all about the grippy texture, with that citrus-sprayed pome-fruit flavor arising in the midpalate. – Matt Kettmann, July 2022

Dark and brooding with layers of spicy dark cherry, this wine is earthy, lengthy and deep in raspberry flavor. Tart, bright acidity lifts the concentrated core of intensity and structure, giving the wine a chance to breathe and coalesce on the palate. – Virginie Boone, Sept 2022

Velvety smooth and earthy in compost and crushed rock and herb, this hearty red wine is rich in red cherry and strawberry, with a persistence of baking spice. Secondary notes of cedar, cigar and oak provide a savory complement and edge. – Virginie Boone, Sept 2022

Thick, tannic and herbal, this is an earthy and ethereal wine from the coast, aromatic in rose petal and forest floor. A notable backbone of acidity keeps it fresh and energetic in the glass amid a savory landscape of salty, silky structure. – Virginie Boone, Sept 2022

Juicy cherry, berry and citrus give life to this bold, lush and brilliant wine, sticky in grippy tannin with a muscular, sturdy structure. Dense and brooding in style, it finishes in bolts of cardamom, vanilla bean and forest. – Virginie Boone, Sept 2022

Focused and deep black-cherry flavors ride soft tannins and a touch of brisk acidity for good balance in this compelling, fruit-driven wine from an immaculate small vineyard above Anderson Valley. Nuances of black tea and rhubarb emerge with more sipping, driving good complexity through the finish. – Jim Gordon, July 2022

Rose and geranium rise from the nose of this aromatic wine, which presents as light and airy in texture despite a full-bodied frame. Rhubarb, pomegranate and cacao nib combine around hints of slate and white pepper. – Virginie Boone, Sept 2022

Fascinating aromas of cranberry and orange peel lead to generous strawberry, red-cherry and redwood-bark nuances on the palate. This medium- to full-bodied wine offers a silky texture, fine-grained tannins and a long-lasting finish. – Jim Gordon, July 2022

Soft, spiced and forest-like in earthy pine and mushroom, this wine offers rich additional layers of red berry and orange zest. Herbal with a hint of white pepper, it is complex, full in style and tight with a tannic grip. – Virginie Boone, Sept 2022

Rounded, with substantial, elongated tannin, this is a richly layered, concentrated wine that expertly showcases the appellation in its embrace of dark blue and black fruit, cola, tea and baking spice. – Virginie Boone, Sept 2022

Woody spice and cardamom accent tingly red fruit in this herbal, earthy wine, crunchy in texture with a length of citrus and red berry. Made in a lush, concentrated style of great power, it finds balance in a finishing touch of acidity. – Virginie Boone, Sept 2022

Black-cherry compote, cola and baking-spice aromas make for a very rich, inviting and delicious nose on this bottling. The palate lands with a lush set of black-cherry and toasted wood flavors, as firm tannins hold the richness together. – Matt Kettmann, July 2022
