



## 2011 FAR COAST VINEYARD Sonoma Coast

Hartford's 2011 Chardonnay Far Coast...apricots, nectarines, butter, honey and spices meld together in the glass...full of promise.

2011 Fog Dance Vineyard GREEN VALLEY OF THE RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY **CHARDONNAY** 

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The 2011 Chardonnay Fog Dance is laced with citrus, matchstick, white flowers, crushed rocks and mint. Bright, fresh and totally articulate, the Fog Dance is another superb wine in this vintage. Floral notes reappear on the finish, adding a vibrant, saline-infused brightness.

2011 STONE COTE Sonoma Coast **CHARDONNAY**  The 2011 Chardonnay Stone Cote Vineyard...is one of the softest, most textured Chardonnays I tasted from the 2011 vintage. Nectarines, orange blossoms, butter and sweet spices all meld together in the glass. It remains oily and lush on the palate, yet not at all heavy.

2011 Four Hearts Vineyards Russian River Valley Sonoma **CHARDONNAY**  The 2011 Chardonnay Four Hearts Vineyards is striking in its beauty. Dried pears, flowers, spices and a hint of French oak are all woven together in a gorgeous wine that captures the essence of Chardonnay from this specific part of the Russian River. Clean veins of minerality frame the saline, bracing finish.

2010 Hailey's Block GREEN VALLEY OF THE Russian River Valley

PINOT NOIR

The 2010 Pinot Noir Hailey's Block ... offers up freshly cut flowers, sweet black cherries, mint, licorice, new leather and a hint of French oak. Vibrant and delineated, the 2010 marries the typical generosity of these Dijon clones in the Green Valley with the cool, insistent minerality of the vintage.

VELVET SISTERS VINEYARD Anderson Valley PINOT NOIR Autumn leaves, mint, tobacco, earthiness and dried cherries all come together in the 2010 Pinot Noir Velvet Sisters. Firm tannins and crystalline nuances typical of Anderson Valley come through loud and clear. Sweet floral notes wrap around the fruit in this poised, chiseled wine. The acidity and freshness of the vintage reappear on the finish, adding distinction and personality.

FAR COAST VINEYARD Sonoma Coast PINOT NOIR The 2010 Pinot Noir Far Coast Vineyard stands out for its deep, resonant personality...there is no shortage of depth and nuance in the glass. Sweet floral and spice notes add lift to the finish.

Fog Dance Vineyard GREEN VALLEY OF THE RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY PINOT NOIR

The 2010 Pinot Noir Fog Dance Vineyard is another wine endowed with serious depth and richness. Juicy dark cherries, cola, new leather, cloves and orange rind all burst from the glass. This is a decidedly rich, explosive wine that stands out for its extroverted personality. Layers of fruit continue to blossom in the glass as the wine shows off its raciness.

Arrendell Vineyard Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR Hartford's 2010 Pinot Noir Arrendell Vineyard captures the best qualities of Russian River Pinot. Juicy and explosive, the 2010 is layered and nuanced throughout. Juicy dark cherries, hard candy, mint and freshly cut flowers are all alive in the glass. The Arrendell has a level of inner perfume, complexity and sheer sweetness that is remarkable. Hints of sage, rosemary and mint add nuance on the close. This is a gorgeous wine from start to finish.

Land's Edge Vineyards Sonoma Coast PINOT NOIR Hartford Court's 2010 Pinot Noir Land's Edge Vineyards brings together fruit from Far Coast and Seascape, a blend that works very nicely. Far Coast provides the body and structure, while Seascape contributes aromatic delineation and energy. There is an element of lift and sheer nuance in the Land's Edge that is wonderful. Here, too, I find superb precision in the flavors.

SEASCAPE VINEYARD SONOMA COAST PINOT NOIR A gorgeous wine, the 2010 Pinot Noir Seascape Vineyard is full of character. Savory herbs, tobacco and licorice are some of the notes that take shape in the glass. Focused, bright and beautifully articulated, the 2011 is an excellent rendering of Pinot from this coastal site just west of Occidental. This is yet another in a series of hugely impressive wines from Hartford Court.

91 POINTS	<b>2011</b> Hartford Jolene's Vineyard ZINFANDEL	The 2011 Zinfandel Jolene's Vineyard is laced with sweet tobacco, wild flowers, sage and rosemary. The style is less obvious than in many of the other wines in this range, instead, the Jolene's relies on its energy and focus to impress, which is does quite nicely. The finish is all about precision and nuance.
91+	<b>2011</b> Fanucchi-Wood Road Vineyard Russian River Valley ZINFANDEL	The 2011 Zinfandel Fanucchi-Wood Road Vineyard, from vines that were planted over 100 years ago, is pure minerality. Exotic citrus peel and floral notes emerge over time.
92 POINTS	<b>2011</b> Hartford Highwire Vineyard ZINFANDEL	A wine of considerable muscle and depth, the 2011 Zinfandel Highwire Vineyard stands apart for its plushness and richness. Layers of dark, floral-infused red/black hued fruit saturate the palate. The 2011 is gorgeous today, but it should also age nicely for at least a handful of years.
93 POINTS	<b>2011</b> Hartford Dina's Vineyard ZINFANDEL	The 2011 Zinfandel Dina's Vineyard is another of the more polished wines in this lineup. Juicy dark cherries, plums, menthol, violets and new leather all take shape in this sensual, layered Zinfandel. This Dina's is arguably the most complete wine in the range of 2011 Zinfandels.
93 POINTS	2011 Hartford Russian River Valley ZINFANDEL	The 2011 Zinfandel Hartford Vineyard boasts gorgeous depth of fruit and pure radiance. Juicy, dark and expressive, the 2011 has tons of palate presence and texture, all while expressing plenty of varietal character and nuance. There is a lot to admire here. Sweet floral notes add a level of brightness that is unusual for an old-vine Zinfandel made from such tiny yields.
