Grapes come from throughout the diverse valley and the wine barrel fermented and given nine months to rest. Full bodied, layered and widely appealing, it shows a density of peach, pear, baking spice and sweet oak, all of the components coming together seamlessly at the end.
94 POINTS	2018 Four Hearts Vineyards Russian River Valley CHARDONNAY	Robust in oak from barrel fermentation and 10 months of aging, this wine is made from four sites within older plantings within the appellation—a showcase of blending and vine age that delivers fleshy lushness and texture. A tension of acidity boosts strong flavors of apple, nutmeg and pear.
97 POINTS	2017 Hailey's Block Green Valley of the Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	Defined tones of red fruit and tangerine, alongside bright acidity, give this wine undeniable lift and life. It is sourced from a coolclimate block within the Arrendell Vineyard. Herbal in thyme and celery seed, it delights the midpalate with length and energy, expanding on the earthy theme with lasting freshness and specks of white pepper and cardamom.
96 POINTS	2017 Jennifer's Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	This rockstar wine is from a cold site south of Sebastopol fed by the Petaluma Gap. Peaty and piquant in licorice, it is rich and balanced, with elongated tannin. Smooth, velvety texture carries strong flavors of blueberry, black raspberry and a tease of grapefruit.
96 POINTS	2017 Land's Edge Vineyards Sonoma Coast PINOT NOIR	Crisp tones of raspberry and strawberry give this coastal-driven red a sense of place and tangy freshness. The acidity is spread evenly throughout on the robust palate, while a forest floor tone and dense tannins add complexity and balanced weight.
96 POINTS	2017 Seascape Vineyard Sonoma Coast PINOT NOIR	From a panoramic estate site above Occidental in view of the Pacific Ocean, this wine is peaty and feral, with plenty of fruitiness to spare. Beautifully layered and crisp in orange peel and plum, it is aged in 100% French oak, 37% of it new, allowing for structure and grace with lasting teases of clove, pepper and briny sea.
95 POINTS	2019 Russian River Valley ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR	This impressively complex wine is breezy in lemon, grapefruit and strawberry flavors, with quenching acidity lifting it up. Salmon in color, it unfurls a balanced texture of richness and crispness with ease, lasting on the palate and mind.
94 POINTS	2017 Arrendell Vineyard Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	From a stellar site planted in 1975 to a heritage clone, this wine is aged in French oak for 16 months. Plum, strawberry and blood orange flavors contribute a palate of balanced richness that is both complex and wide in appeal.
94 POINTS	2018 Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	This is an outstanding wine for the price, made from a majority of estate-grown grapes across the appellation. Given 10 months in French oak, 27% of it new, it is designed to be delicious out the gate, with a lush opulence that is soft, broad and supple across the palate. Plummy and brimming in dark cherry and cola, it finishes with moderate structure and baking spice.
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Near the outpost of Fort Ross, this is a wild, coastal site, and it provides intense grip and

power. Juicy and broad in orange peel, dark cherry and strawberry, it has undeniable

earthiness and accents of rock and iron, finishing with a lengthy lushness.

93 POINTS	Fog Dance Vineyard Green Valley of the Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	From a foggy site near Forestville, this is a reductive, brawny wine with plenty of weight and backbone. Earthy and herbal, it offers a density of red and black raspberry, with hints of tangerine, the tannins expansive and velvety smooth.
93 POINTS	2017 MacLean's Block Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	Juicy, smooth and velvety, this block selection is full bodied, fleshy and lushly opulent, with soft integrated tannin. The ripeness pushes and offers a warmth of rich cherry cola, baked plum and earthy cinnamon.
93 POINTS	2017 Sevens Bench Vineyard Carneros PINOT NOIR	A spicy nose leads the way to the appellation's earthy funk and a length of cherry vanilla that balances it well. Powerful and weighty, the wine is juicy in orange and tangerine on the midpalate, with firm, supple tannin support and hearty oak.
96 POINTS	2018 Highwire Vineyard Russian River Valley ZINFANDEL	This wine is sourced from an estate site planted to 100-yearold vines, with half the parcel head-trained and the other half trained on a high wire, thus the name. Tangy orange peel, cherry and blackberry mesh around a densely layered core. It's complex and rich, but buoyed by bright acidity and a shock of white pepper.
95 POINTS	2018 Dina's Vineyard Russian River Valley ZINFANDEL	Aged in all French oak, 56% of it new, Dina Arata's old-vine site contributes soft supple waves of mocha, coffee and black-cherry-berry flavors. Juicy lengthy tannins and generous oak give it power and substance within a graceful buoyancy and lasting freshness.
94 POINTS	2018 Fanucchi-Wood Road Vineyard Russian River Valley OLD VINE ZINFANDEL	Dusty sage, earth and leather exude out of 100-plusyear-old vines from this famous dry-farmed site in the heart of the appellation. The fruit is intensely brambly and feral, a mix of blackberry, black cherry and dark fig with dustings of cocoa powder and clove
94 POINTS	2018 Hartford Vineyard Russian River Valley OLD VINE ZINFANDEL	From a low-yielding, head-trained vineyard planted more than a century ago, this wine tastes of dried fruit, dust and nutmeg, with a depth of rich black cherry. Leathery texture leads to an elegant length of velvety softness.
93 POINTS	2018 Jolene's Vineyard Russian River Valley OLD VINE ZINFANDEL	Head-trained old vines give this wine substantial concentration and a soft fleshy core of lush dark-berry fruit. Nutmeg and black pepper give it a contrast of savory and sweet seasoning wrapped in well-integrated oak.
93 POINTS	2018 Russian River Valley OLD VINE ZINFANDEL	This appellation wine comes from a blend of five vineyard-designated sites, all old vine, dry farmed and low yielding. Velvety and expansive on the palate, it has broad appeal in its rich density of cherry, strawberry and fleshy texture. Supple tannins and integrated oak allow a finishing touch of white pepper.
