2018 This coastal wine comes from a site north of Fort Ross and at high elevation. Rich and Far Coast Vineyard rounded in style, it has texture and complexity that complements and tames the opulent Sonoma Coast flavors of peach and vanilla. The finish is spicy and lifted, with a lasting tang. Enjoy from CHARDONNAY 2028-2032. Cellar Selection. - Virginie Boone, Aug/Sept 2021 2018 This is a gorgeously crafted, complex and structured wine, made from a cool-climate site at **95** SEASCAPE VINEYARD 1,150-feet-elevation near the town of Occidental. Meyer lemon citrus bursts from the Sonoma Coast opening, leading the way to a silky texture of great tension and acidity. Green apple, Asian CHARDONNAY spice and a taste of tea round out the finish. - Virginie Boone, Aug/Sept 2021 2018 An exuberantly fruity, fleshy and pleasing wine, this shows concentrated flavors of green apple, Fog Dance Vineyard pear and mandarin. The acidity is moderate and the oak spicy, with hints of nutmeg, GREEN VALLEY OF THE lemongrass and Nilla Wafer that remain fresh and focused in the glass. RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY - Virginie Boone, Aug/Sept 2021 **CHARDONNAY** 2019 Lushly tropical with a richness of crème brûlée, this wine is made from several sites in the Four Hearts Vineyards Laguna Ridge neighborhood of the appellation. Generous oak supports the layering opulence RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY and spiciness, offering a voluptuous expression of the grape. - Virginie Boone, Aug/Sept 2021 CHARDONNAY 2018 Creamy texture akin to salted butter leads the way to a mineral-driven midpalate of stone, **93** Sevens Bench Vineyard citrus and peach in this delightfully complex and balanced wine. Hints of baking spice and Los Carneros dried herb provide additional character and intrigue. - Virginie Boone, Aug/Sept 2021 **CHARDONNAY** 2018 From a block within the Arrendell Vineyard, this is an earthy, hearty and generously ripe wine, **96** HAILEY'S BLOCK smooth and complex with underlying brightness. Dense layers of black cherry and berry meet GREEN VALLEY OF THE a savory edginess of forest floor and black tea, showcasing the beauty and brawn of the variety. RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY - Virginie Boone, June/July 2021 PINOT NOIR From two vineyard sites just a few miles from the Pacific Ocean, this wine is juicy in cranberry 2018 **95** LAND'S EDGE VINEYARDS and pomegranate. Lifted accents of white pepper, orange peel and rose add complexity and nuance to the robust frame. - Virginie Boone, June/July 2021 Sonoma Coast PINOT NOIR 2018 A full-bodied, generously flavorful and robust wine, this is spicy and earthy in tree bark, cedar **95** MACLEAN'S BLOCK and dried herb. Fresh acidity confronts a wall of riotous intensity of crushed rock and deep, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY dark cherry. - Virginie Boone, Aug/Sept 2021 PINOT NOIR 2018 This is made from one of the coldest sites in the appellation, planted in 1975 to a single clone. **94** Arrendell Vineyard Cranberry, cherry and strawberry fruit adorn a plush and velvety palate of textured intensity RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY and tannin, with jolts of black tea, dried herb and forest complementing and contrasting. PINOT NOIR - Virginie Boone, Aug/Sept 2021 2018 From a high-elevation site on a mountain ridge north of Fort Ross, this blustery, full-bodied **94** Far Coast Vineyard red shows the extremes of its growing conditions, offering broad, bright and fruity intensity. SONOMA COAST Juicy black cherry, plum and blackberry fruit meet graphite, dark chocolate and crushed rock, PINOT NOIR a note of sea spray and forest never far behind. - Virginie Boone, June/July 2021

Rose petal, crushed rock and baked cherry accent this structured, complex wine that is tremendously balanced and full of elegant depth. Fleshy, lush and creamy on the midpalate, it evolves to show a hint of cola, black tea and black pepper, forest notes never far behind. – Virginie Boone, June/July 2021



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92 POINTS	2018 Sevens Bench Vineyard Los Carneros PINOT NOIR	A supple and sultry red wine that is brimming in baking spice and tannin, this small-production wine shows the appellation's funk and earthiness to great effect. Tree bark, tea and a bit of barnyard work well within a generously full-bodied context of concentration and dense red fruit. – Virginie Boone, Aug/Sept 2021
92 POINTS	2019 Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	Rounded, with substantial, elongated tannin, this is a richly layered, concentrated wine that expertly showcases the appellation in its embrace of dark blue and black fruit, cola, tea and baking spice. Editors' Choice. – Virginie Boone, Aug/Sept 2021
94 POINTS	<mark>2020</mark> Russian River Valley ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR	Made predominantly from grapes grown at the Fog Dance Vineyard, a vineyard-designate of its own, this memorably delicious wine is light in color and delicately inviting in tangerine, peach and strawberry. Stainless-steel fermented, it remains crisp on the palate with just a touch of orangesicle richness on the finish. Editors' Choice. – Virginie Boone, June/July 2021

2019 Russian River Valley OLD VINE ZINFANDEL Dark licorice, dust and sage meet a thread of white pepper in this deliciously built, powerful and complex wine from an old-vine estate site. Juicy blackberry dominates on the midpalate in concentrated form, seasoned in graceful hints of nutmeg and oak. – Virginie Boone, June/July 2021

Seductively smooth and weathered in crisp cranberry, plum and dark cherry, this old-vine wine offers a substantial grip of tannin and notes of crushed rock and oak. Velvety texture leads to dusty black pepper, nutmeg and tobacco. – Virginie Boone, June/July 2021

A dry-farmed site planted 100 years ago and head-trained still, Dina's is a study in baked cherry, blackberry and plum, rich and viscously thick. Velvety tannins and ample weight provide an unctuous lushness that is complemented by underlying acidity. – Virginie Boone, June/July 2021

Dense black fruit contrasts against a tartness of cranberry, the acidity sharp and beautifully complementary to the dry-farmed, head-trained structure of the wine. Powerful grip speaks to its youthful vigor, unwinding slowly in the glass. – Virginie Boone, June/July 2021

Succulent, with structure and tension in its bones, this hearty, full-bodied wine expresses thick waves of juicy blackberry, dark cherry and cola, the oak well-integrated within a spicy component of nutmeg and white pepper. Planted more than a century ago, the head-trained vines yield low amounts of delicious, concentrated grapes. – Virginie Boone, June/July 2021

Not much of this was made, sadly, as it delivers velvety thick, rich and tension-filled grip around firm, structured tannin. Blue and black fruit dominate in concentrated form, dusted in nutmeg and oak, from vines more than 100 years old. – Virginie Boone, June/July 2021

This is a blend of five vineyard designates and it shows serious power and elegance in one cohesive body of thick richness and weight. Tightly wound in tannin, with ample toasted oak, it offers satisfying layers of black raspberry, cherry, cola and white pepper, overdelivering on its price. 2015 Outer Limits Vineyard Sonoma Coast SYRAH

2014 Russian River Valley PORT ZINFANDEL It can be hard to find coastal Syrah, so this hearty version from the producer's Far Coast Vineyard stands out in several ways. It is lifted in tones of dried herb, lavender and garrigue, with a meaty midpalate that is notable in blueberry and game flavors. Supple, integrated tannins and oak accents surround it all. – Virginie Boone, Aug/Sept 2021

Made from old-vine grapes grown at Jolene's and Fanucchi vineyards this wine was then fortified with Germain-Robin brandy. Viscous, unctuous and softly textured, it tastes of blackberry cobbler, nutmeg, gingerbread and Christmas spice. – Virginie Boone, Aug/Sept 2021
